

The GSSI was established after the 2009 earthquake in L'Aquila, with an explicit intention of supporting the recovery of the local social structure and motivated by the desire of contributing to the rebirth of the city following a model of 'City of Knowledge' supported by the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD).

We're taking concrete steps to pursue social engagement promoting a university "third mission" based on the application, promotion, dissemination and knowledge transfer, creating know-how and new technologies to contribute to the social, cultural and economic development of society.



The economic and social structure of L'Aquila allows to revision the city a knowledge-driven city of national and international significance, as already stated in previous OECD work (OECD 2009). First, it hosts a large university; second, it hosts the word-renowned Laboratory of Gran Sasso and the newly established Gran Sasso Science Institute (GSSI doctoral school); third, as any other capital city hosts the production of services with a high content of human capital.


